## Goldsmith 300 (TEC conf. room - level B)

This room utilizes a ceiling-mounted projector, focused on a manual, wall-mounted screen.

## Displaying video sources

- 1. Use the black, System Control pop-up on top of the Instructor Cart. If necessary, push DOWN on the cover to access the pop-up controls. The station rolls a few feet in the instructor area! *Roll back when done!*
- 2. Press the <u>PROJ ON</u> button. Projector will take 45 seconds to warm up. *No controls will function during warm up*.
- 3. After the warm up period, select your preferred input by pressing the appropriate buttons. (Buttons illuminate when active.) There is a lock out period of several seconds after input selection, when you cannot jump to another source. Just re-select your source after a few seconds.
  - Press the <u>PC/LAPTOP</u> button to activate the Instructor PC stored in the Instructor Cart. Courtesy USB ports are available on the front of the PC.
  - A Laptop connection, provided via a VGA cable with attached audio connector, is also available at the Instructor Cart. If connected properly, the system will automatically switch form the installed PC, to your laptop. MAC and Display Port users should provide their own adapter. A power outlet is available at the control pop-up. In Rm 300, we recommend you set your laptop to a resolution of 1024x768 for best results.
  - Press the <u>DVD/S-VIDEO</u> button to select the DVD player, stored inside the Instructor Station. Use the player's on-board control buttons or its remote control to control your disc.
  - VHS (VCR) legacy tape playback: Please contact Media Technology Services (MTS), 781-736-4632 in advance, to request the temporary loan of a VHS player. All requests are subject to inventory availability.
  - If your image does not appear but you do hear sound, wait a few seconds and re-select your input.
- 4. PC LOGON: \*\*Use your UNET name and password, in the USERS domain. \*\* Laptops going wireless may select the EDUROAM network, using your full UNET address & password. Alternately, the GUEST network can be accessed using a personal email address. Open a browser to access that logon process.
- 5. Press the <u>AUTOIMAGE</u> button will to adjust the projector to attempt proper sync with your laptop. *In Rm 300, we recommend XGA resolution (1024x768) for best results.*
- 6. Press the <u>AV MUTE</u> button to black out both video and audio. Press it again to return to your presentation.

## **Audio Controls**

- 1. Press the  $\underline{AUDIO\ up}$  and  $\underline{AUDIO\ down}$  buttons to control your levels.
- 2. Press the <u>AUDIO MUTE</u> button to mute all sound levels. Just press it again to regain sound.





## When Finished

- 1. Press the PROJ OFF button. Be sure the projector begins to power off with its 90 second cool down process. It is important to shut off the projector to save lamp life!
- 2. Return any remote controls to the station.
