This room utilizes a ceiling-mounted projector, focused on a wall-mounted screen. A 2nd. screen is also installed for simultaneous display of traditional av.

Displaying video sources

1. Use the black, System Controller on top of the Instructor Station. Push DOWN on the cover to access the pop-up controls. The station rolls about 10' in the instructor area! *Roll back when done!*
2. Press the **PROJ ON** button. Projector will take 45 seconds to warm up. *No controls will function during warm up.*
3. The most recent input will display in the corner of the screen.
4. After the warm up period, you **MUST** select your preferred input using the appropriate buttons. *(Buttons illuminate when active.) There is a four (4) second lock out period after input selection, when you cannot jump to another source. Just re-select your source after the 4 seconds.*
 - **PC/LAPTOP** will display the installed PC. *A courtesy USB port is available on the PC, front left side.*
 - **Laptop** connections are provided via a VGA & audio cable, accessed thru the pop-up controller. The system will **auto-detect**, and switch to a laptop when properly connected. A power plug is available in the control station.
 - **DISPLAY RESOLUTIONS:** the data projector can display most resolutions, though **we recommend 1024x768 (XGA) for best results.**
 - **BEST PRACTICE TIP:** before powering on or opening up your laptop, connect both ends of the cable and select the **LAPTOP** input on the control panel. At this point, power on and open up your laptop. **MAC users must provide their own MAC adapter.** *Refer to our "laptop display tips" for more info.*
 - **PC LOGON:** Use your UNET name and password, in the USERS domain. **Going wireless? If not in the UNET USERS domain, you may logon as a "guest user" with your email address. **
 - **DVD/S-VIDEO** selects the DVD player, stored under the Instructor Desk. If needed, you can unlock the door using the access code as provided above. **AUDIO CD's** can also be played from the DVD, as well as from your laptop or PC.
 - **VHS/VIDEO** selects the VHS player in the same location. You may operate the video devices using controls on each unit, or with provided remotes.
 - **External video/audio sources** may be presented (such as a camcorder). Plug into one of the inputs, under the control buttons. System will **auto-detect** & display.
5. The **AUTOIMAGE** button lets users adjust the projector to a proper sync and display. This feature is under construction.
6. The **AV MUTE** button blacks out video and audio. Press it again to return to your presentation.

Audio Controls / Lighting Controls

1. Press the **AUDIO ^** and **AUDIO v** buttons to control your levels.
2. **AUDIO MUTE** button mutes all sound. Press again to regain sound.
3. **Light switches** are located on the back wall next to the entrance door.



When Finished

1. Press the **OFF** button at the wall control panel. **Be sure the projector shuts off to save energy and save lamp life!**
2. Return or neaten up any cables to help maintain the facility.
