Wireless internet access is available in the conference room!

Technology instructions

Each room contains a 50" wall-mounted plasma display panel (PDP).

Acquire key from administrative offices

Turning on the system

Locate the plasma remote control, *either* attached to the side of the plasma screen or stored in the equipment cart.

1. Turn on with the "**ON**" button
2. Select input choices with the "**SOURCE**" button

Laptop Display

- There are two laptop connection points in the room, one in the conference table pop-up, and one on top of the equipment storage cart.
- It is recommended to turn on the plasma and select input "**PCI**" first.
- Next, connect your laptop to either: the table pop-up using the supplied 15 pin cable w/audio (stored in the equipment cart). OR - At this point, turn on your laptop. ([PC LOGON - Use your UNET name and password, in the USERS domain. **For wireless connectivity, you may log in as a guest user with your email address, once your card recognizes the network.](#))

VHS or DVD display

Inside the equipment cart, you will find the VHS & DVD players, into which you may insert your tape or disc.

1. On the plasma remote control, select "**AV**" for the VHS player, or select "**COMPONENT**" for the DVD player. Source select confirmation appears on the screen's top left hand corner.
2. Use the VCR or DVD controls on the units themselves, or on the provided remote controls, stored in the AV closet. [An infrared repeater, located on top of the plasma screen, will allow you to use these remotes in the conference room, with the equipment cart door closed.](#)
3. Volume levels for all sources are controlled via the plasma remote control, **VOL + or -**. Be careful to use the "**MUTE**" button only when desired. Volume levels are confirmed on the bottom region of the plasma screen.

Playing an Audio CD or other media

Audio CDs may be played on the installed DVD player, or by using your laptop's CD drive. Other media choices may be played by ordering support equipment from Media Technology Services @ 6-4632 or 6-4429.



Please turn off all items when finished. The OFF button is located on the top right hand corner of the plasma remote. Return all remotes and cables to their proper storage location. Thank You!
