

Goldman-Schwartz 115 *(TEC classroom – level B)*

NO access code needed.

This room utilizes a ceiling-mounted projector, focused on a SCREEN-PAINTED WALL as a display surface.

Displaying video and computer sources

1. Use the black, System Controller on top of the Instructor Station. Push **DOWN** on the cover to access the pop-up controls. The station rolls about 6' in the instructor area! *Roll back when done!*
2. Press the **PROJ ON** button. Projector will take 45 seconds to warm up. *No controls will function during warm up.*
3. After the warm up period, you **NEED** to select your preferred input by pressing the appropriate button. *(Control panel buttons light up when active.)*
 - **PC / LAPTOP** will display either the Instructor PC in the lectern, or your properly connected laptop. *A courtesy USB port is available on the PC.*
 - **LAPTOP VGA & LAPTOP HDMI:** These connections are provided via extension cables at the Instructor Lectern. A VGA cable w/ attached audio connector allows traditional VGA connections. *If you have selected **PC/LAPTOP**, and devices are properly connected, the system will auto-sense your laptop and display on the screen.* An HDMI cable is also available at the Lectern for laptops with digital only output. Select **HDMI** for such devices. *There will be a delay as the digital system processes the signal. You MAY need to send your signal using your laptop function keys.* A power outlet is available at the lectern and at the wall.
 - **AUDIO (VOLUME) levels are controlled using the AUDIO ^ and AUDIO v and MUTE hard buttons, found on the control panel.**
 - **DVD** and **VHS** buttons respectively select either the DVD player, or the VHS player, stored in the Instructor Station. Device controls are on the units themselves, and the DVD player remote control is provided at the Instructor Station.
 - **AUDIO CD's** can also be played w/ the DVD, your laptop, or the PC.
 - **DISPLAY RESOLUTIONS:** the data projector can display most resolutions, though **we recommend 1280x1024 (SXGA) for best results.** **The control panel allows you to adjust or mute the image, as well.**
 - **BEST PRACTICE TIP:** before powering on or opening up your laptop, connect both ends of the cable and select the **PC/LAPTOP** input on the control panel. At this point, power on and open up your laptop. **MAC & DISPLAY PORT users must provide their own adapter.**
 - **PC LOGON:** Use your UNET name and password, in the USERS domain. ***Your laptop should be wireless!** If not UNET registered, you may logon as a "guest user" with your email address. *

Light Switches

These are located on wall as you enter the room, allowing users to darken the projected image area. **Contact Brandeis Facilities 6-8500, for lighting support.**



When Finished

1. Press the **PROJ OFF** button. Be sure the projector begins to power off with its 90 second cool down process. **It is important to shut off the projector to save lamp life!**
2. Return any remote controls to the station.
3. The station does not currently lock.
