

UNDERSTANDING DISPLAY SETTINGS

Not seeing what you expected?

If the monitor displays your normal laptop background without any of your icons, you are seeing an “Extended Desktop.” The monitor is providing additional blank desktop space instead of showing (duplicating) your laptop’s screen. To take advantage of the extra space or work with multiple documents, drag open windows from your laptop screen onto the Extended Desktop.

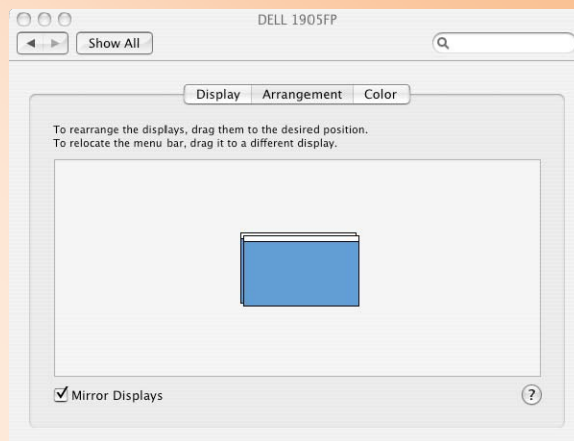
To change this setting, follow the instructions below.

LAPTOP DOCKING STATION

How to Change the Display Settings:

On a Mac

- On the Apple menu, select “System Preferences”.
- Click on “Displays”.
- Click on the “Arrangement” tab.
- To duplicate your laptop screen on the monitor instead of extending your desktop, click on the “Mirror Displays” checkbox.



On a Dell

- Cycle through the different display options by pressing the “Function” and the “F8” keys simultaneously.
- For additional display options, visit the LTS Help Desk on Goldfarb Level 1 for assistance.

The best resolution for the monitor is 1280 x 1024. If prompted, select that option.
